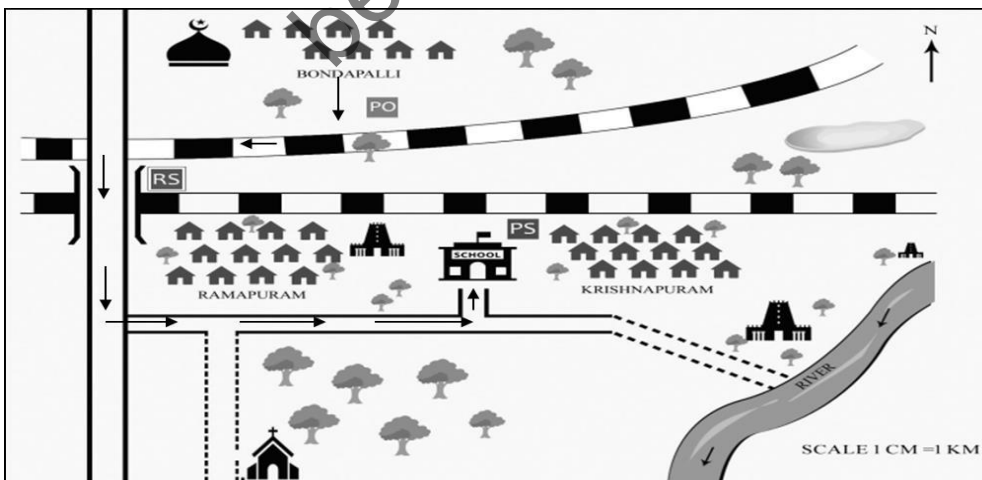

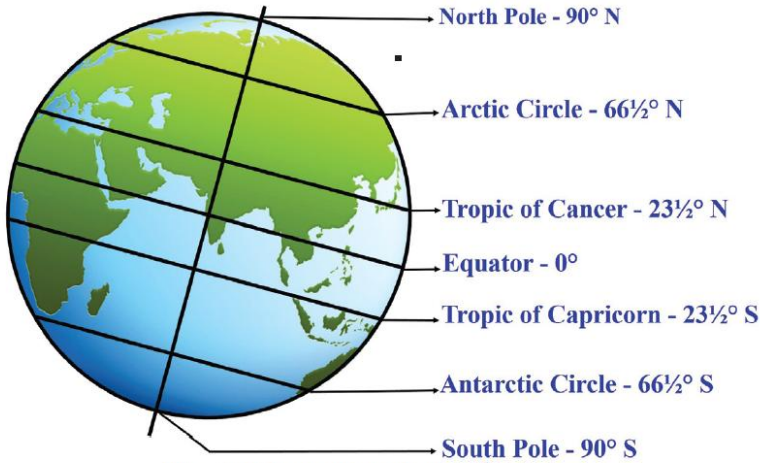


Fig. 2.5 Important Latitudes
