Rachel Carson (born May 27, 1907, Springdale, Pennsylvania U.S.—died April 14, 1964, Silver Spring, Maryland) American biologist well known for her writings on environmental pollution and the natural history of the sea.

Carson early developed a deep interest in the natural world. She entered Pennsylvania College for Women with the intention of becoming a writer but soon changed her major field of study from English to biology.

After taking a bachelor's degree in 1929, she did graduate work at Johns Hopkins University (M.A., 1932) and in 1931 joined the faculty of the University of Maryland, where she taught for five years.

Why was Rachel Carson influential :

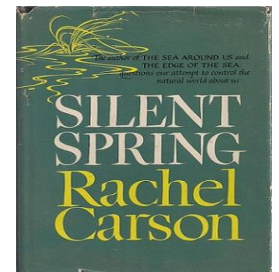
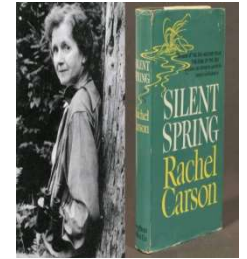
Rachel Carson was an American biologist well known for her writings on environmental pollution and the natural history of the sea. Her book, *Silent Spring* (1962), became one of the most influential books in the modern environmental movement and provided the impetus for tighter control of pesticides, including DDT.

What did Rachel Carson write :

Rachel Carson's first book, *Under the Sea-Wind*, was published in 1941. *The Sea Around Us* won a National Book Award, and *The Edge of the Sea* was published in 1955. Her influential *Silent Spring* (1962) became a best seller.

Death :

Seriously ill with breast cancer, Carson died two years after her book's publication. In 1980, she was posthumously awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom. Her homes are considered national historic landmarks, and various awards bear her name.
